Subject: CANOE Interim survey report

Hi everyone:

Having returned from my trip, I worked as fast as I could to produce a quick survey report for discussion during our next conference call. I logged 7,900 KM in 17 days along the route. I had to cut my trip short by a few days or risk being stuck in Yellowknife for up to a month longer. After I arrived in Yellowknife, Highways announced that the ice bridge was closing the next day for the season.

There was plenty of snow yet which is something I expected but I believe that most of it is gone now.

I left the diagrams of the different legs of the array as separate documents. I scanned and included 3 pictures I took with one of my cameras. I had these pictures developed enroute. The rest of the pictures will be here next week and I will forward them to you. The picture I included are of a NWTel repeater station on the Alaska Highway not far north of Watson Lake Yukon. Then there is a picture of Caribou along the same stretch of road. I am waiting for information on costs of using NWTel sites and I hope to get that next Monday.
